I am A.V., 48 years old, a psychologist, and your faithful listener.

Radio messages help to get closer to spiritual values. I was extremely impressed by the reading of the psalms, especially psalm 121, which urges people to turn to the true God, who never slumbers nor sleeps, but is always awake, taking care of people. This psalm invites us to walk with God, to look up beyond our fragile existence, to find steadfast confidence in our daily walk.





Man is the bearer of the divine image. But it does not entitle man to compare himself to God or to worship another creature in the image of God. And man has really moved away from God; the gifts originally given to him have been distorted, but these gifts should be developed and invested in the maintenance of creation, not to destroy it...

Your comments and comparisons are an endless source of thought and reflection for me. After hearing the interpretation of this psalm, I decided to deeply study all the psalms, analyze myself and bring out their important sayings. When working with my patients, I often ask them to find harmony by listening to the word of the Lord, praying to find balance and spiritual calm.

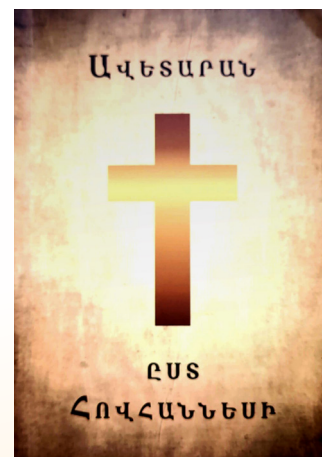
Thank you for your mission. I wish you an uninterrupted airtime.
